Benefits

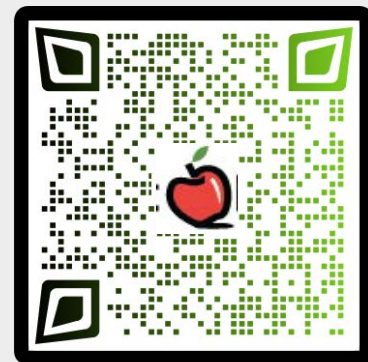
BOLD is different... It's more than access, it's outcomes...

- We handle the loan process with the student and college
- Employment begins after graduation
- The employer pays annually based on the original agreement with our organization

Local Outreach & Initiatives

We're involved in various outreach initiatives across South Carolina, including:

Administration of the South Carolina Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program

The State of South Carolina forgives loans for eligible teachers who teach in geographic or subject areas of critical need. We provide the staff and system to administer the SC Teachers, Career Changers, and PACE forgivable loan programs.

\$1K College Giveaway

Each month, we give away \$1,000 to a lucky local high school student, college student, or their parent to help pay for college.

Financial Aid/Parent Nights and College Fairs at South Carolina high schools

Our staff travel around the state to host and attend events for high school students and parents who are planning for college. Our advisers reinforce the guidance of school counselors and present our services as options for paying for college.
